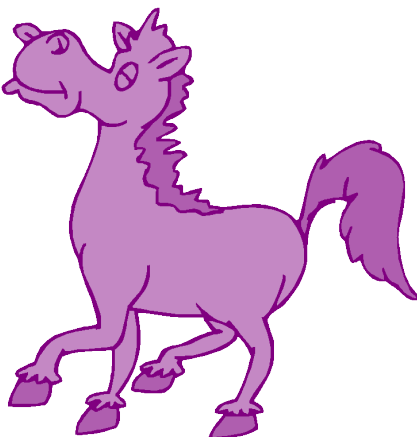


What to Take to the Horse Show

6. Hay net

12. Water bucket
13. Fly Spray & Rag
14. Treats
15. Clippers
16. Grooming Tools & Sprays
 - Rubber Curry Comb
 - Face Curry Comb
 - Stiff Brush
 - Soft Brush
 - Hoof Pick
 - Mane Brush & Comb
 - Grooming Cloth
 - Sweat Scraper
 - Scissors
 - Cleaning Spray
 - Mane Detangler & Shiner
 - Coat Polish Spray

 - Jacket
 - Long sleeve shirt/Ratcatcher
 - Stock Pin
 - Boots
2. Helmet
3. Gloves
4. Spurs
5. Hair Stuff (brush, comb, rubber band, clips)
3. Sun Screen
4. Clear Rain Slicker

Get Ready to Show!

One to Two Weeks Ahead

- Bathe horse & Body clip
- Wash stable blanket & leg wraps

The Week of the Show

Sunday

- Clean out horse trailer, including tack room
- Inventory supplies & make a replacement list

Monday

- Buy supplies

Tuesday

- Clean all tack
- Get show clothes together, wash if necessary

Wednesday

- Clean & pack hats, boots & spurs

Thursday

- Do touch-up clipping on legs, ears, bridle path & face
- Pack show clothes and as much equipment as possible

Friday

- Bathe horse
- Wash brushes
- Blanket horse & put in clean stall
- Finish packing

Hitch up horse trailer

Other Tips

- Plan to arrive at the show at least an hour before the show starts
- Allow an extra half hour for travel
- Allow an extra half hour to get up and out of the house
- Set your alarm clock half an hour earlier than your plan requires
- Example:
 - Show starts at 8:00 AM
 - Planned arrival time: 7:00 AM
 - Travel time: 30 minutes
 - Travel time cushion: 30 minutes
 - Get up & ready time: 60 minutes
 - Get up & ready cushion: 60 minutes
 - Wake up time: 4:00 AM
- Try to keep as much packed and in the trailer as possible.
- Have a second set of brushes that you only use for shows
